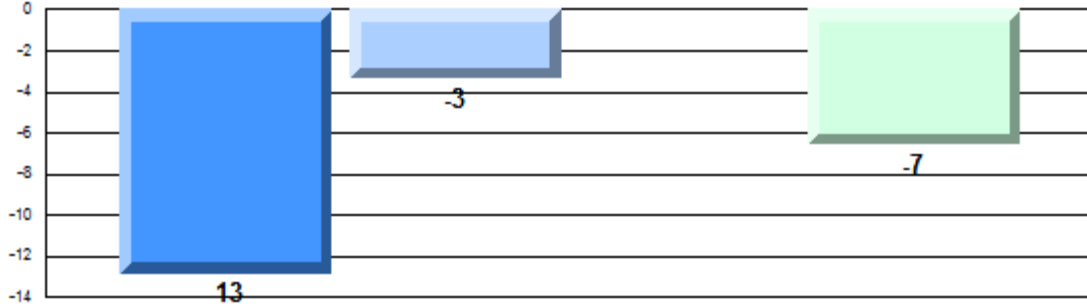


Written Response: Percentage of students meeting/exceeding grade level expectations 2012-2015

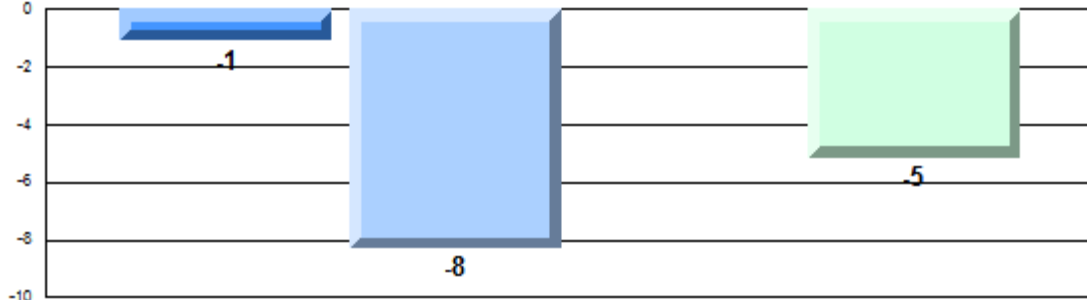


Written Response: Percentage of students meeting/exceeding grade level expectations 2012-2015
